Important Camper Information

Dear Camper:

We are very happy to have you with us at Day Camp on Stiles Pond this year. Please read and have all enclosed information filled out and returned to the Y prior to your first day at camp. This information is very important and should be saved as it is the only notice you will receive prior to camp.

Please be at your pick up point ten minutes early the first day, and if the bus should be late, PLEASE BE PATIENT AND WAIT FOR IT. You will be able to know better when the bus will come after the first couple of days. Each day you should still arrive at the stop early. A parent or guardian should wait at the bus stop with you.

You will be returned on the bus some time between 4:00 and 5:00 PM. Camp begins at 8:45 AM and is over at 3:45 PM. Generally the bus leaves camp a few minutes late the first day. Camp is held rain or shine.

The YMCA Medical Form is enclosed to be filled out by your parent or guardian and returned to the Y or camp prior to the first day of your camp period. If a doctors medical form is sent in, please fill in the Y's medical/release form and attach the doctors form to it.

Notice: If your child is on special medication, an authorization form must be filled out and signed by a parent or guardian prior to the first camp day. This form is available at the YMCA. State law requires that this form be on file at the camp.

What to Bring

Campers should bring a lunch, bathing suit and towel to camp. All clothing should be CLEARLY MARKED with camper's name. A gym type bag or back pack should be used to carry campers belongings. This bag can also be used to store campers clothes while swimming or boating. The YMCA has Tote Bags for sale at the Y's front desk. Dungarees or shorts and tee shirts make good camper outfits.

Day Camp Store

A Camp Store is available to campers. A variety of fruit flavored drinks and snacks will be sold. This is optional to the children. Campers are responsible for their own money. At morning attendance campers can turn in their money to their counselor and it will be given back to the camper just prior to store. There is a \$1.00 limit in the store each day.

Camper Absenteeism

If your child is sick or for any other reason cannot attend camp, please call the Y's office at 1-(978)774-2055 and leave a message on the Day Camp Voice Mail Box.

Family Nights and Campers Fun Nights

During the first week of each period the Y will hold a Family Night for the families to visit the Y camp facilities, meet the staff and go for a swim. In the event of inclement weather, family night will be cancelled for that session. A Campers Fun Night will be held during the second week of each session. The Fun Night is optional and an additional fee is charged to cover expenses. Fun Nights are held rain or shine.

Care For Mildly Ill Campers

While at camp if a child is mildly ill the child's temperature will be taken. Parent will be called while child rests in a cabin. Parent will be requested to pick up the child as soon as possible.
